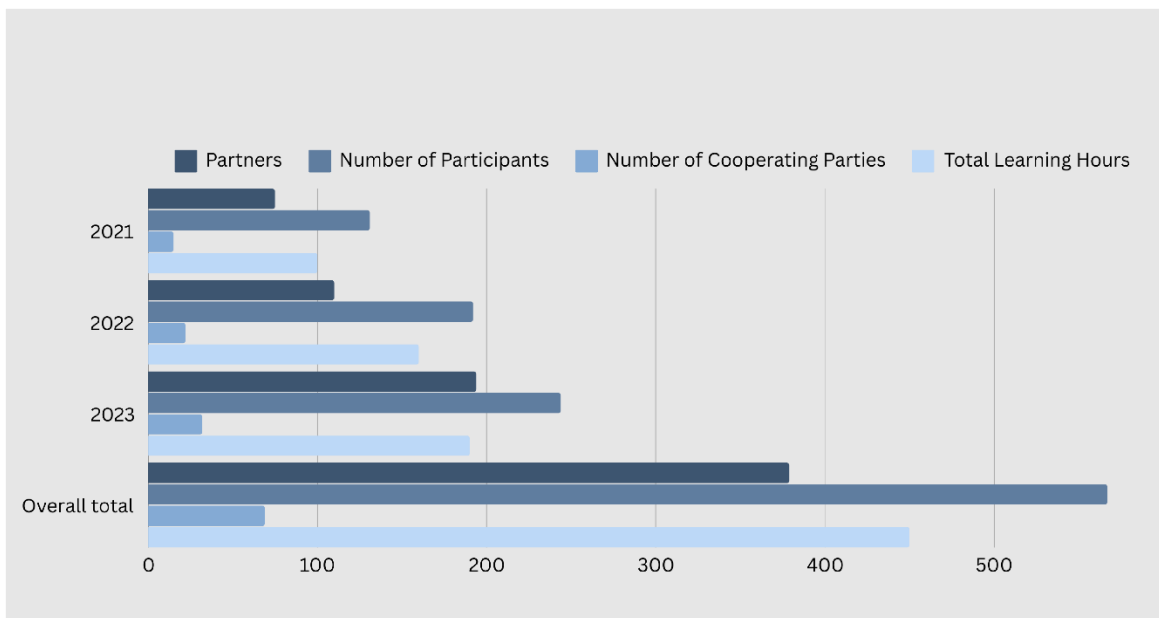


Lamea Association

Lamea employs a rigorous selection process to identify outstanding youth from both public and private sectors. The intensive training program includes over 1,200 hours of workshops and experiential learning, covering leadership development, strategic thinking, and effective communication. Approximately 85% of participants report significant improvement in their leadership skills, and they benefit from connections with over 200 industry leaders and mentors. This program has successfully engaged more than 500 young leaders since its inception, and graduates have launched over 50 community initiatives that address local challenges. By enhancing individual capabilities and promoting collaboration, Lamea creates a robust network of future leaders ready to make an impact.
